


## Kents Hill School - Reception News


We will be starting a weekly visit to the library very soon. This is a time for children to choose a library book to share at home. Reception children will all have library time on a Friday afternoon.



We will also continue with our PE lessons, all children will need a named indoor PE kit in school, including plimsolls. This should be left in school on your child's peg. PE will be on Friday afternoons.



In Read, Write, Inc. children have been learning all of the set 1 sounds. These were sent home last half term. They will be split into four groups from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> November so that adults can focus even more on individual children's needs.



Please continue to read and share books with your child and write in their reading record. Always keep the reading record and book in your child's book bag so that they are available for the teacher to write in and change. We will be reading with a group of children each day and aim to hear every child read at least once a fortnight.



Also, to let you know in advance, we will be walking to the local woods on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> November. If any parents are available to join us during the school day, please let us know as we will need some helpers with us. More information will follow soon.



Please make sure children have appropriate clothing for the weather. All children must have appropriate footwear and a suitable coat in school.
