

English

- We are learning to write an explanation text this half term. The children will learn by heart the explanation text "The Teacher Pleaser". They will explore all the features of an explanation text and use these features to write their own explanation text.
- Children will innovate the explanation text. For example, "The Policeman Pleaser" or "The Head teacher Pleaser".

Music

- Children will continue to explore musical scores.
- As composers, the children will create their own musical scores.
- Children will use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs,
