Dear Parents and carers,

Here are some updates on the exciting learning we have happening during the rest of this term.

Junk Modelling request.

During the week beginning 30th January, your child will be designing and making a musical instrument. For this your child will need either –a cardboard tube, such as a Pringles tube, a plastic bottle or a small box or container. Please bring into school CLEAN and in a plastic bag by Monday 30th January.

Carnival Dress up day- Wednesday 8th February.

To celebrate the end of our Rio de Vida topic Year One are going to have a dress up carnival day. On Wednesday 8th of February, your child can come to school dressed in bright coloured clothing. We will have a range of activities to bring together all their learning about Brazil.

In our PE lessons we have learnt a range of dance movements. We have worked in small groups to combine these dance moves into a Rio Carnival Dance.

On this same day, Wednesday 8th February, at 2:15pm, the children would like to invite their parents/friends/carers to come and see them perform their carnival dance.

Winter Walk to the woods

To continue their Science learning about seasons, we will be taking another walk to the woods during the final week of this half term. The children will be looking at the environments and make observations to any changes since their last visit during the autumn. They will look for signs of winter and find out more about their local environment.

Elm will visit the woods on Monday 6th February in the afternoon and then Chestnuts will visit on Thursday 9th February. On these days your child will need to wear their school uniform, a warm coat, hat, scarves, gloves and a change of shoes (such as wellington boots) to ensure their school shoes stay clean.
